PART 1: REFLECTION

You have probably heard these verses spoken at a funeral many times. Why might you choose them? What do they do for your heart?

In what ways do you feel loved by Jesus through these words?

Listen! What else is He saying to you today to encourage your heart?

PART 2: REFLECTION

Verse 6 is almost as well known as John 3:16. How does it impact you especially in today's pluralistic culture?

“He who has seen me has seen the Father” – What have you been learning about the Father by seeing Him in Jesus?

Jesus said, “If you really knew me, you would. . .” How is he completing that sentence for you today?

PART 3: “DOING THE SAME & GREATER - WOW!”

The first time I read/heard these next words of Jesus, I had only one response – Wow! I wonder how the disciples felt? I wonder how you will feel?

READ JOHN 14:12-14

1. “Because I am going,” Jesus says. If they could see past the loss for a moment, what benefits has Jesus promised because He is going? Refer to earlier passages as well.

2. I would imagine the disciples asked Jesus to do things for them during their time together. What do you think they might have been thinking when they heard Him say “in my name?”

3. What do you think they thought the “greater” things might be?

PART 3: REFLECTION

“Anyone who has faith in me,” Jesus says, “will do . . .” That means you! What kind of experiences have you had where you did the same things or greater things than Jesus?

If you have had little, or no experiences like those of Jesus, what do you think are some reasons for that?

Would you begin asking Him “in His name” to see an increase of all dimensions of His ministry in your life, not for your glory, but for His - not for your glory but for the expansion of His message and kingdom?
