PART 2: “THE PROTECTION PETITION – PART 2”

READ JOHN 17:13-17

1. What does it mean for the disciples (and us) to be in the world but not of it, the same as Jesus was?
2. What additional protection request does Jesus make for the disciples?
3. In the Greek, the word sanctify means to make holy or set aside for sacred use. Why would Jesus pray this for the disciples?
4. How is one “made holy” according to Jesus’ request?

PART 2: REFLECTION

How well are you doing at being in the world but not of it? Take a moment to listen to the Lord and see what He thinks. Remember, His correction is for your good!

How are you doing spending time in His Word? Remember His word is a major tool for transforming you and making you holy – i.e., like Him.
